



### **Wavion and Vipitel Partner to Provide High Speed Internet Access for the State of Aguascalientes, Mexico**

The network includes 38 Wavion base stations: WBS-2400 and WBS-5800, working in the 2.4 GHz and 5.8 GHz respectively. The Wavion base stations were installed on poles and roof-tops along the city streets. The 2.4 GHz network provides internet access to the citizens of the state and the 5.8 GHz network provides the backhaul.

Moreover, the flexible architecture and rugged weather-proof enclosure add significantly to the unique value offering for telecom operators.
